Apply for Disaster CalFresh food benefits between **February 10-14 and February 18-19, 2025** by calling (866) 488-8482 (M-F, 8:00am to 5:00pm), or by visiting æLos Angeles Department of Public Social Services office to apply in person.

Complete the application and interview with the @g5 b[Y Yg Department of Public Social Services. This will happen at the same time you apply.

Pick up your EBT card. If you are approved for Disaster CalFresh food benefits, Los Angeles Department of Public Social Services will tell you when and where to pick up your EBT card. Let your worker know, if you are displaced and not staying in Los Angeles County. The county can make your card available at a local Social Services office near you. An EBT card is like a debit card which you'll use to purchase food.
